
Example of: **Grow Spiritually as a Worship Team**
(*Leader Guide*)

(Useful Information for effectively leading this Worship Workshop...)

Time: 2 Hours (Full Workshop) **OR** 10 – 15 Min. per week (Weekly Devotionals)

Audience: Entire Worship Team

Supplies: Bible, Pen, Paper, Leader Guide, Team Edition copies (1 per team member)

Suggestions: Ask team members to read along in their Bibles and ask for volunteers to read the scripture passages. *(Don't mention the "theme" of the verse / passage until 'after' the scripture has been read and summarized by the team members.)* This workshop is intended to be introspective, especially during "A Closer Look" and "What Next" sections.

Alternative: It may work better for your team to break the Workshop up and do it as a "mini – devotional" at each practice. In this case, use one of the passages for each week. Devotional times will likely vary from 10 – 15 minutes each.

What Next: Commitment to continue growing spiritually.

Jeremiah 7:2 – 3 - (Alternative - Devotional 1)

Theme: Can't worship in a sinful lifestyle.



Questions:

- Can someone summarize these two verses for us?
- Did God say, “Just ask for forgiveness” and keep going down the same path?
- Did He say, “I am “Love”, therefore you can live here?
- Was he referring to all people or just those coming to worship the Lord?
- Where is there sin in YOU that is keeping authentic worship from occurring?
- Are you harboring bitterness towards someone? Anyone on the Worship Team?
- Are you the cause or the recipient of dissention within this church?
- What about within the worship team?



A Closer Look:

- God is referring to those coming to worship Him only.
- He desires to reward His people, as they obey Him.
- We must fully obey Him to truly receive His rewards and worship Him purely.
- God will never truly bless this team to the fullest when sin is present.



What Next?

- Where in “your” life is there sin that is standing in the way of worship?
- What are you going to do, starting today, to “reform your ways”, so you can help our worship team to worship Him in purity and truth?
